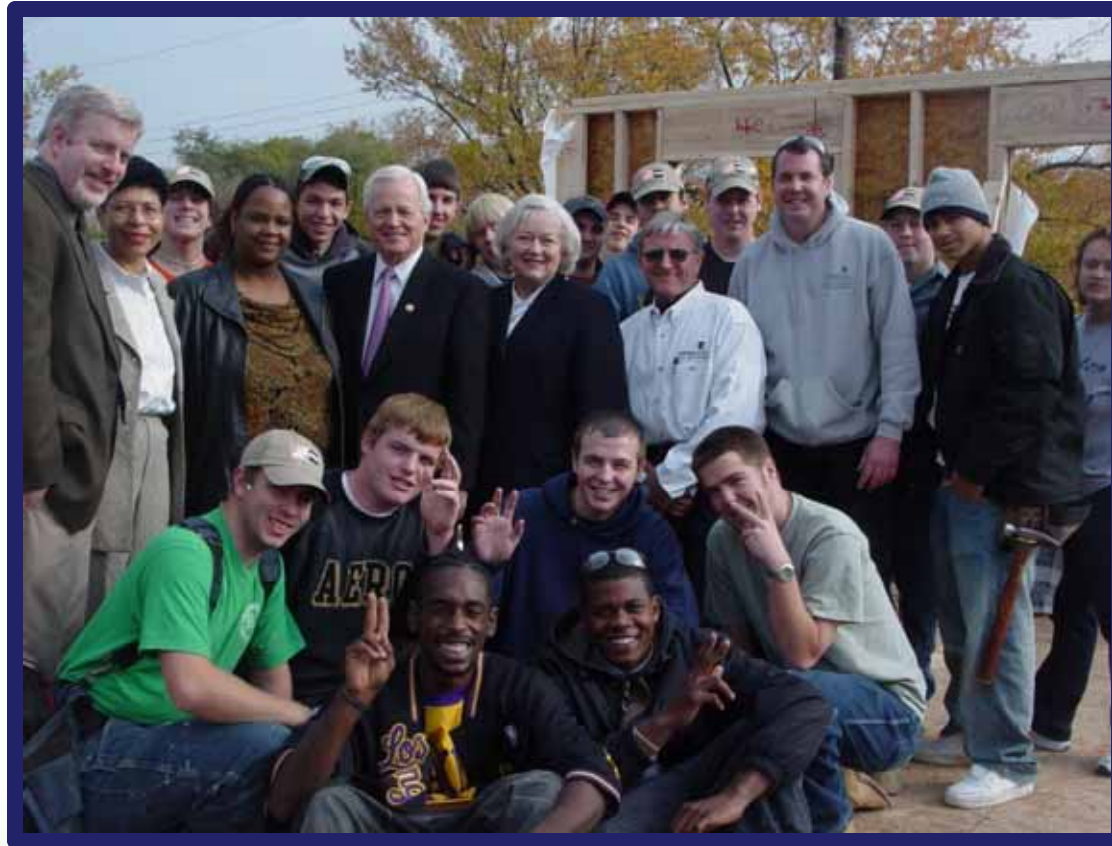

- **problem-solve**

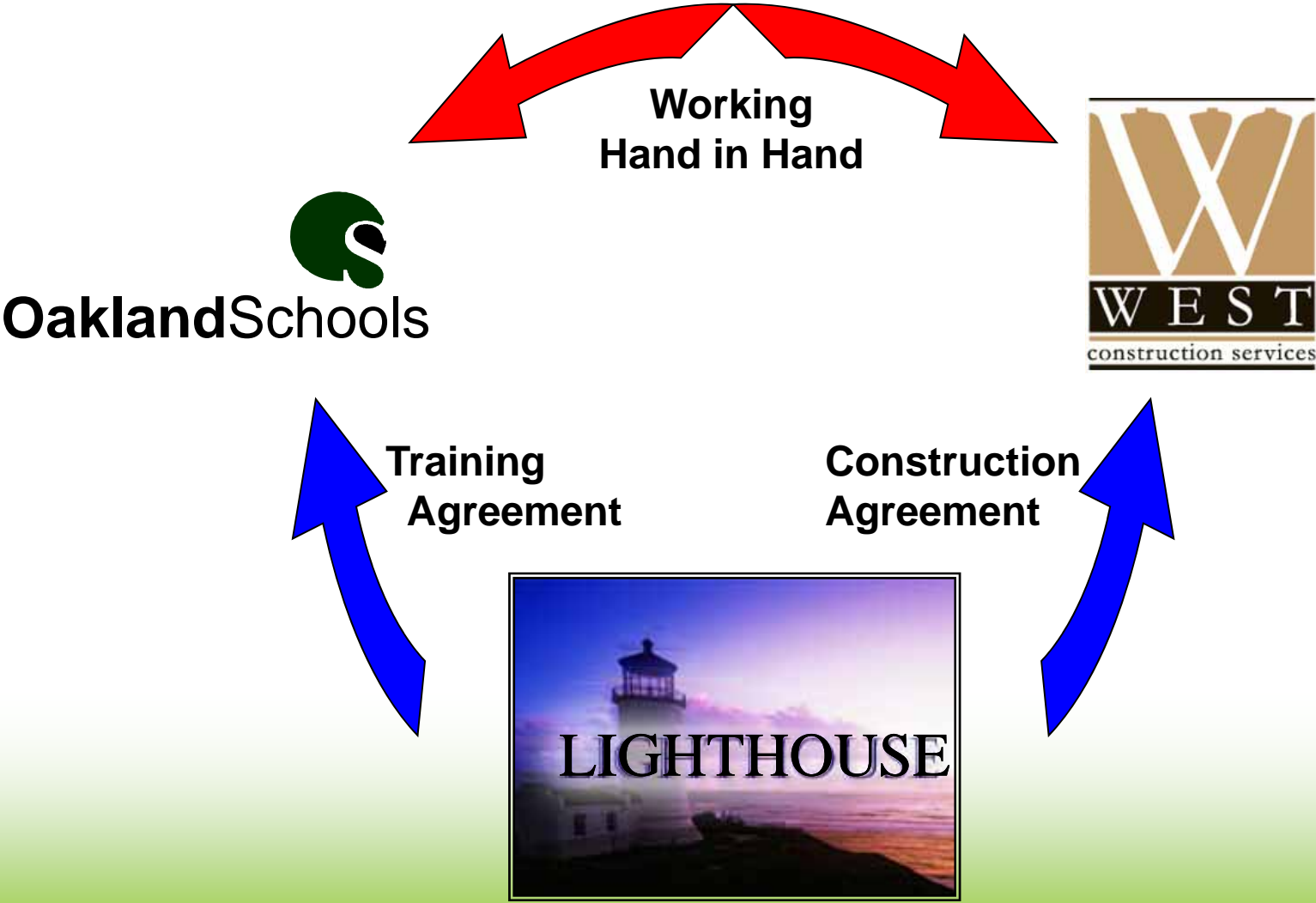

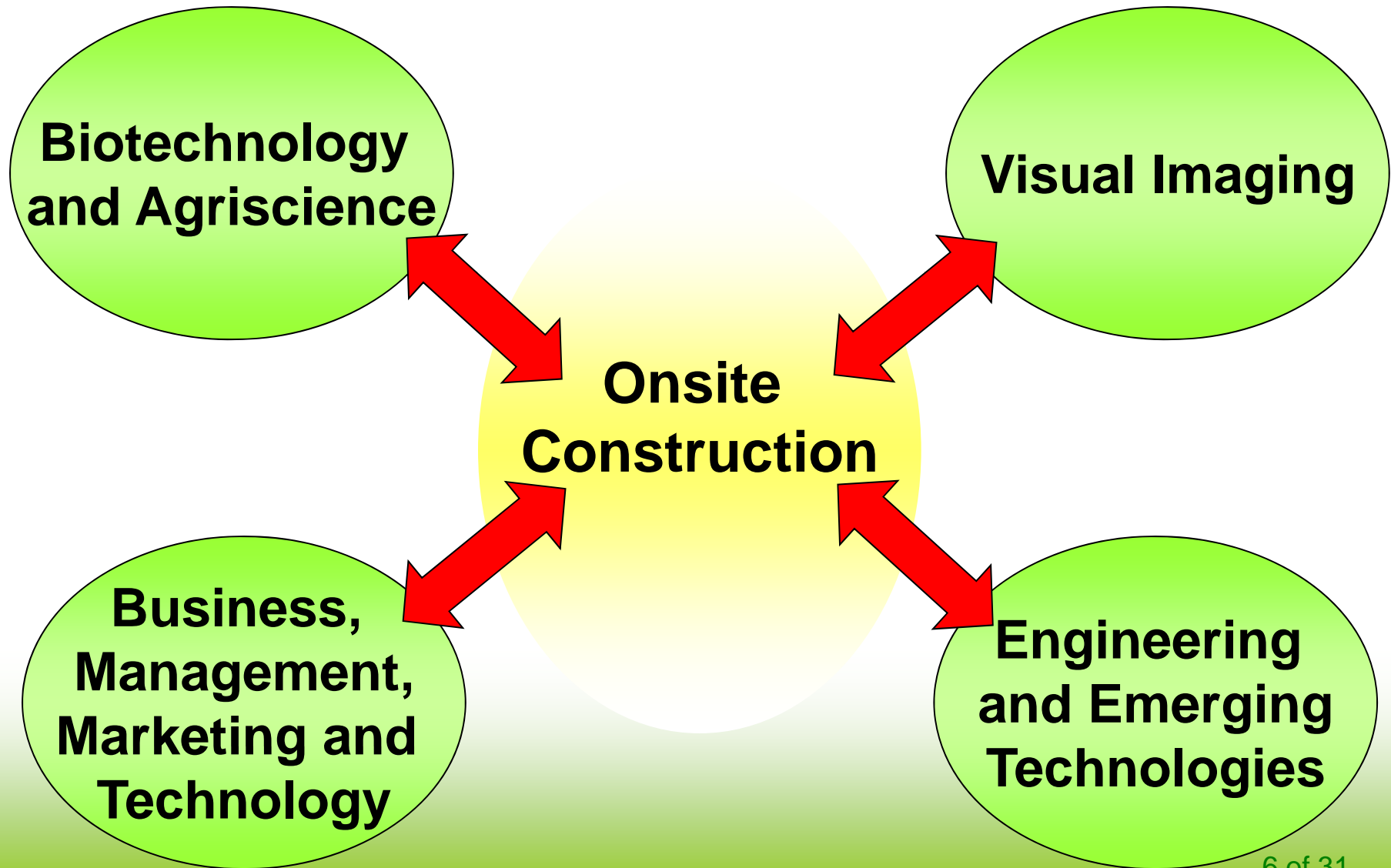
