The Michigan Career Development Model (MICDM) was designed to provide all K-12 students throughout the state with the necessary knowledge and skills for success in the career of their choice and lifelong learning.

### **Grade Level Bands, Zones, and Targets**

The MICDM provides required targets and suggested instructional strategies to meet those targets, organized by state-specific grade level bands.

To successfully meet MICDM targets and implement strategies, Galaxy ensures success by offering districts and elementary schools across Michigan a career awareness system that includes:

- Exposure to a broad spectrum of careers, including those that are nontraditional and not gender specific.
- Engaging games, activities, and experiences that support knowledge and skill development, social emotional learning, and career awareness.
- Information for parents, designed to encourage family engagement.
- Participation in activities that facilitate career awareness and identify interests.

## Galaxy Support and Alignment

#### **Incorporate Grade-Level Specific Career Development**

In 2018 several bills were passed in MI legislature requiring school districts to take an active role in assisting students as they prepare for their future education and careers. As a result, districts must incorporate grade level career development education within their educational delivery system, beginning in Kindergarten.



Kuder Galaxy® (Galaxy) is an online career awareness system for students in grades pre-K through five that makes learning about the world of work fun by igniting the playful spirit of young learners through a series of engaging games, activities, and experiences.

#### Offer Career Development at Each Grade Level

The MICDM provides targets and strategies, organized by K-12 grade level bands. Although the model groups grades into bands — i.e. K-3 and 4-6 — **districts are** expected to deliver career development at each grade level.



Galaxy contains developmentallyappropriate tools, resources, and activities for pre-K through five. It is customizable to include guidance specific to Michigan's grade level objectives.

For example, state-specific targets and strategies can serve as "I Can" Statements in order to monitor progress and success.

#### **Engage Parents in Students' Career Development**

Suggested strategies outlined in the MICDM include writing letters to parents introducing the K-5 career awareness process; create a hub of information for parents; and more.

#### **Participation in Career Interest Activities**

Michigan districts should offer students access to activities and tools to help identify personal traits and characteristics that may link to career interests and future careers.



As students progress through Galaxy, they identify and gather information about careers; their personal interests; and characteristics of people who work in specific occupations.

In addition, the MICDM suggests character-building activities — i.e. Who am I? What are values, strengths, citizenship, etc.?

To facilitate this, each level of Galaxy focuses on a specific question — i.e. What is work?, What do people do at work?, What tools and skills do people use at work?, and How can I learn more about occupations that interest me?

#### **Career-Focused Curriculum and Academic Connection**

Suggested strategies outlined in the MICDM include embedding career awareness activities in curriculum through career-focused education, and helping students connect academics to careers.



In grade 4, students using Galaxy have access to videos, activities, and text to help them answer their grade's focus: What kinds of training and education prepare people for work? At this level, Galaxy helps students link what they are learning in the classroom to possible future careers.

Additionally, curriculum to help teachers and counselors deliver effective career-focused education will be available later this year.
